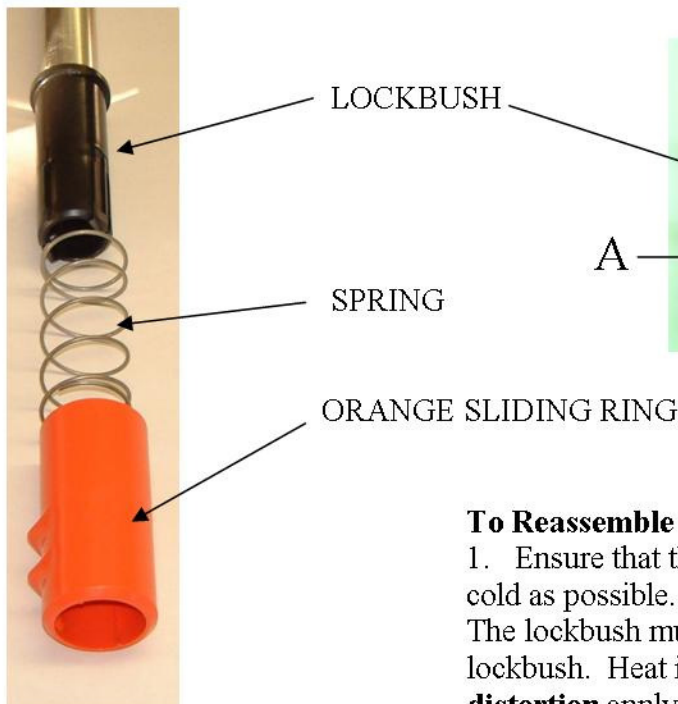
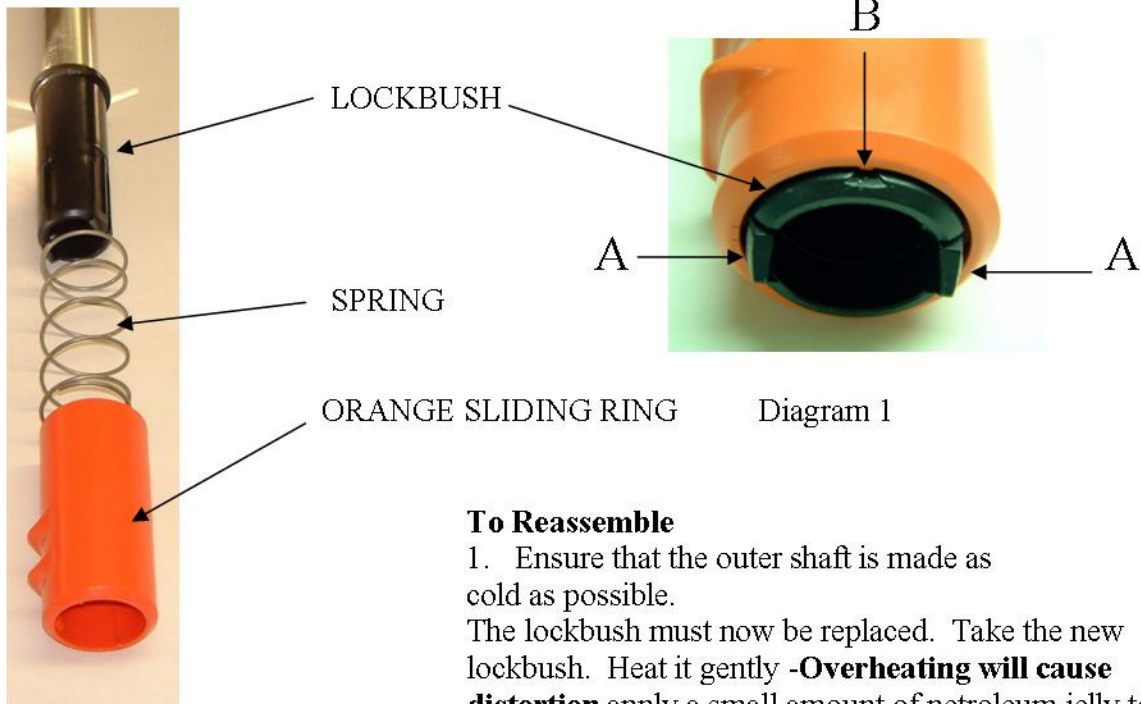


Combisystem Telescopic Handles Art. No. 3711/3712
To Disassemble

1. Pull back the orange sliding ring and withdraw the sliding inner shaft assembly.
2. Take the outer shaft assembly, grasp and hold the projecting lugs A, (see diag 1) wrap a strong elastic band around them to hold them together.
4. Take a screwdriver, and with the tip, locate and push on point B (see diag 1). **BE CAREFUL—KEEP FINGERS CLEAR-AVOID INJURY!**
The orange sliding ring and spring will then release, and can be withdrawn (see diag 2).
5. The lockbush can now be removed. To do this, heat the bush gently with a hair dryer or hot air gun, and with a gloved hand firmly grasp, twist, and pull off. **RISK OF BURNS-BE CAREFUL TO AVOID INJURY**


To Reassemble

1. Ensure that the outer shaft is made as cold as possible.
The lockbush must now be replaced. Take the new lockbush. Heat it gently **-Overheating will cause distortion** apply a small amount of petroleum jelly to the end of the outer shaft. **RISK OF BURNS-BE CAREFUL TO AVOID INJURY!**
2. Take the lockbush, making sure that the shouldered end is pointing downwards.
3. Fit it to the outer shaft with firm continuous downward pressure from a gloved hand.
4. Re-fit the spring and orange sleeve (see diag 2), making sure that the grooves on the lockbush are in alignment with the lugs on the orange sliding ring. Press down firmly until it 'clicks'.
5. Operate the mechanism several times to ensure full alignment.
